


Being qualified in PRINCE2 and SMSTS, Barnaby has also benefited from investment in CAD software to become proficient in producing 3D visuals and renders.

After careful selection, we were instructed to build not one, but six of our premium event structures including the Show Ground Reception, a Media Centre, a Techno Zone and a large Social Area for staff and volunteers The weekend was full of sunshine being some of the UK's hottest days of the year. We hope to experience the same when we return in 2019!

Specification

- 'Techno Zone' Two 25m x 40m curved roof premium structures with white flat keder fed linings
- 'Show ground reception' A series of $5m \times 5m$ Pagodas
- 'Media Centre' A 15m x 25m structure, fitted with cassette floor and hard sides
- 'Social Area' Two 15m x 24m structures with split levels connected with a walk way

Using a range of premium structures (in the wake of the Beast from the East) with clear roofs, printed cobbled carpet and a flat white lining. We even added a clear roof viewing area structure for the breath-taking firework display which capped the evening.

 Dance Floor
- 15m x 20m Parisian High Street and Viewing Platform
- 10m x 30m Kitchen, Toilets and Bar Storage
