

Structures as great as your ambitions

A complex build.

Some marquee builds are trickier than others, and the Fews team are very experienced in overcoming any number of obstacles. The Igloo structure in the Old College Quad was a complex build in an enclosed space.


The first issue was a network of underground tunnels beneath the quad meaning we had to very careful in ensuring there was limited weight burden on vulnerable areas.

The second issue was the very tight space we had to work in, with the 20metre x 50metre Igloo marquee with its 14metre internal height being constructed entirely within the Quad and positioned very carefully to avoid placing weight above the underground tunnels.

The third was one of very restricted access. The entire Igloo structure, cherry pickers, trucks and other build equipment had to go through a narrow 3.5 metre-wide arched entrance at one end of the Quad, also with very limited parking on the roadside beyond.

It is a testimony to our project planning, site management and careful rigging crews that the structure was positioned perfectly with no damage to the buildings or ground.

When a venue was required for Shakespeare's 500th birthday we got the part.

Saturday, April 23rd 2022 saw the celebrations of William Shakespeare's 458th birthday across Stratford upon Avon.

Central to the birthday luncheon was The Pragnell Shakespeare Birthday Award which was presented to Adrian Lester, the latest in a long line of theatre greats.

The main structure was a 20metre x 65metre Premium Fews Marquee on a 3metre leg. In addition, there was a 10metre x 15metre marquee containing the reception area, cloak room and kitchens.

The walls were a mix of ABS panels, glass windows and glass double doors. We fitted a level ring beam cassette floor throughout with access ramps. Bespoke white flat tack-off linings were fitted to the walls and white flat opaque leg boxes to all window bays.

Case Study / Aston Martin Cognizant Formula One Hospitality Marquee

Case Study / RMS for Girls – Temporary Classroom

The Requirement

The Silverstone Grand Prix is one of the iconic races in the Formula One calendar, and the Aston Martin brand was returning to the circuit after a gap of 60 years, last appearing in 1960.

To celebrate the return, the Aston Martin Cognizant Formula One Team hosted VIP guests at their factory across the road from the Silverstone circuit.

F1 Team hospitality sets a very high bar, therefore the quality of structures, finish and branding needed to meet exacting standards.

Bespoke Entrance Walkway & Car Plinths

- Installed a bespoke entrance walkway was built from the access road to the main hospitality marguee using new timber decking.
- Custom decking steps were installed to all three elevations allowing unimpeded access.

Branded Gable

25m wide, one-piece graphic was produced to be stretched taut across the main entrance gable.

Main Hospitality Marquee

- 25m x 40m Clear-span Premium Marguee with the central section including a clear PVC roofs to give natural light inside.
- Sitting on a cassette floor system covered by a grey carpet and oak brown vinyl flooring.
- Installed two elevated car plinths with black vinyl to showcase the recently launched DBX and DBS.

RMS is one of the oldest girls' schools in the country. Founded by Chevalier Ruspini in 1788, the school's original purpose was to educate the daughters of Freemasons who were unable to support their families through death, illness or disability. Today, the school accommodates pupils aged 2-18 with some day and some full weekly and flexi boarding.

In late 2021, RMS discovered structural problems with their existing assembly hall, and needed an alternative building for two years to enable necessary repairs to be carried out to the existing facility. RMS approached Fews to provide a turnkey solution that needed to be fully functioning by April 2022.

The Background

The Requirement

The Fews Solution

- Installed a 20m x 40m structure for the main building and a 5m x 5m structure for the entrance vestibule.
- Installed a level integrated cassette floor system to provide a sound structural base.
- Insulated wall panels and an inflated thermo PVC roofs were specified to help reduce the energy costs of mechanical heating and cooling.
- The spaces were fitted out with bespoke MDF wall panelling with skirting and dado rail.
- Demountable and washable roof lining was installed with lights behind to provide a diffused spread of light.

- Installed a complete lighting and electrical package with builtin sockets, emergency lights, mains distribution board as well as overhead radiant cassette heaters on a digital thermostat control.
- Dedicated on-site Project Manager planned and oversaw the complete installation and included the provision of temporary welfare, aluminium access trackway, site fencing and temporary power.



Case Study / University of Warwick Graduation Ceremony

The Requirement

Through early July 2022, The University of Warwick held its Graduation Ceremonies for the classes of '20 and '21.

The postponed celebrations for the Summer 2020, Winter 2021 graduates, and Summer 2021 cohort took place between Tuesday 5 – Friday 15 July 2022

A very large marguee was required to accommodate the number of students – Covid 19 had caused the delay of the previous year's ceremony.

The Fews Solution / Igloo

- We provided a 30m wide x 90m long Igloo marguee structure with a 30m x 15m round end. To create the right atmosphere, clear PVC was fitted to the round end for the reception area making it a bright welcoming space.
- Above the audience we fitted white PVC to reduce the internal temperatures and maximise the effect of the lighting, with black PVC above the stage area.
- Around the structure we fitted Igloo double doors with emergency exits from the main and backstage areas.

Due to the uneven nature of the site, we fitted an elevated long grid floor system. The drop from corner to corner was 1.6 metres presenting a technical challenge for a structure of this size.

Throughout the period of the ceremonies the UK experienced fairly high temperatures so six high-power heat pump chillers were installed around the Igloo with white diffusers inside.

Case Study / An Experiential Structure

When the FIFA World Cup was held in Brazil, a country known for its high temperatures and challenging humidity. As part of a promotional experiential event, we built the 'Lucozade Sport Conditions Zone' – a bespoke, state-of-the-art immersive experience in Canary Wharf.

The idea was to offer up and coming footballers a chance to play their game in the same conditions as those being experienced by the England Team. The average conditions of England's opening World Cup game in Manaus, Brazil were temperatures of 32°C and 76% humidity.

The Requirement

The Fews Solution

- 20m x 35m structure was used for the Condition Zone 5-a-Side pitch and reception.
- Adjoining 15m x 35m structure provided space for the "Conditions" lab, changing rooms, and back of house area. The Conditions Zone provided a unique experience for players and visitors alike.
- Zone itself as well as the additional facilities required to accommodate players, press, and of course the Conditions Lab, where players performance levels would be analysed.

Fews sustainable story is one of continued investment and process refinement towards out goal of NET ZERO. At every step we have sought to ensure that our carbon footprint is as low as possible, focussing clearly where the maximum gains can be made.

From investment is Biomass and Solar energy, to sourcing our own fuel in the form of woodchip, purchasing the latest efficient vehicles, and developing a highly efficient PVC cleaning machine, Fews' journey has been one of total commitment to the future our planet.

2012 250K investment in Biomass heating

Fews invested in an efficient, comprehensive biomass system to utilise a near carbonneutral energy source. We use locally sourced wood that cannot be used for other purposes.

This system provided energy for:

- Full heating system and hot water for office and warehouses
- Power for PVC Cleaning Process
- Cleaning, drying, and preparing linings Keeping stock dry through the winter

2015 300K investment in Solar Panels

In 2015 we further extended our commitment to the environment by introducing solar power with an investment of over £300k.

A continued investment in biomass

Investment of over £1 million in an efficient, comprehensive biomass system to fuel our warehouse and offices, including the supply of heating and hot water

- Biomass is an especially attractive fuel source because huge amounts of it are generated inadvertently through industrial and agricultural production
- Harnessing this waste material and extracting more energy from it improves all-around efficiency and reduces the ecological impact mankind has on the environment
- Fews only use wood that cannot be used for other purposes like clippings, prunings, and other arboricultural arisings

Woodchip from sustainable sources

Fews utilises its own wood-chipping service to produces biomass woodchip from sustainable sources through brash removal and site clearance.

- Our in-house collection team are the "wombles" of the industry -making sure we use and recycle wood that would otherwise be discarded
- We collect from within an average six mile radius of our offices
- Once prepared on our drying floor it is used as fuel for the biomass boilers. This helps to make our operation as sustainable and efficient as possible
